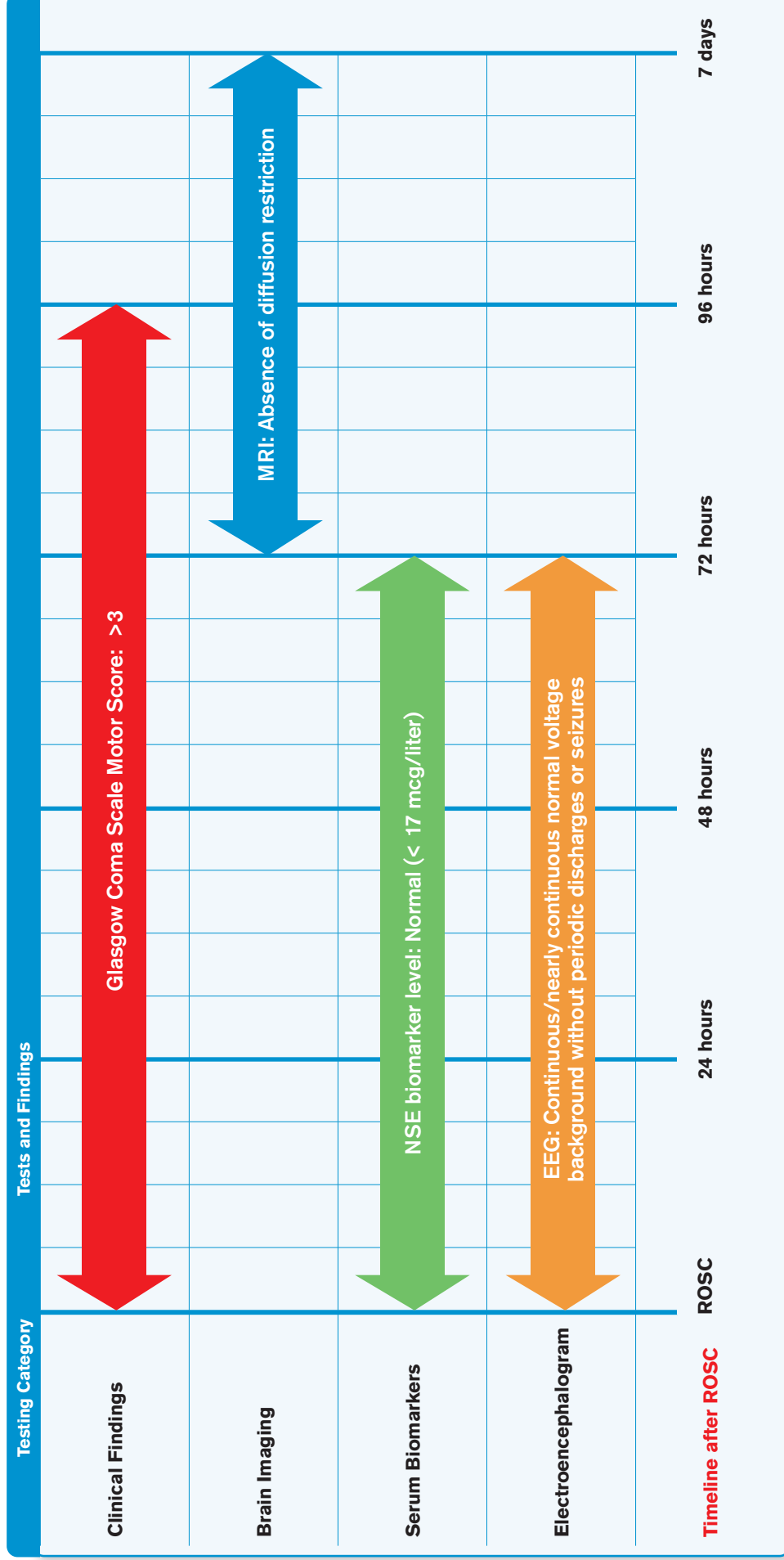

The information below identifies *testing modalities* that can be used by healthcare professionals for predicting an increased likelihood of favorable neurological outcome in adults who are comatose after ROSC. It is important to note that no single test should be used in isolation for prediction of a good neurological outcome.



MRI: Magnetic resonance imaging
NSE: I Neuron-specific enolase
ROSC: Return of spontaneous circulation
